Approval of Minutes: Minutes from July 9, 2024 board meeting were reviewed and approved via unanimous vote

Friends of Collegedale Library Report (FOCPL):

Sarah presented the FOCPL report which highlighted:

- Friends of the Library membership is currently at 58
- There was a membership drive with a raffle that added 20 new members
- Waitlist for the Zoo pass. Funding received for a second pass (\$250 dollars annually). There are currently 50 patrons on the waitlist.
- Scholastic Books \$1385.89 Summer Reading
- Sponsorship of Libby costs \$2905 annually
 - o \$1,000 for maintenance
 - \$1905 for content
- Library patron donated a beautiful transportation quilt to be raffled
- FOCPL hosted their final two author talks of the year
 - Miranda Smith- 60 in attendance
 - o Tyler Boyd- 12-15 in attendance
- Hosted a Murder Mystery event in partnership with Collegedale Parks and Rec
 - o 30 adults and 12 children in attendance
- Purchased a new Free Little Library for \$389.95
 - Composite material with two stories for books
 - Waiting on final placement after Imagination Station upgrades
- Annual holiday book sale is scheduled from December 14-28
 - Volunteers needed

Quarterly Library Report:

Regina presented the quarterly library report which included the following:

- Statistics at a Glance:
 - o 37,094 materials in physical circulation from July to September 2024
 - o 14,514 materials in electronic circulation from July to September 2024
 - 95 library programs executed from July to September 2024
 - 2,765 attendance for programs held between July to September 2024
 - o 19,133 library visits occurred between July to September 2024
 - o 1,229 computer usages from July to September 2024
- *Highlights:*
 - o New Therapy Dog
 - o 1,000 Books before kindergarten
- Library Update
 - New software installed called Comprise. Will allow for remote printing.
 - Summer reading programs
 - At approximately 50% which is the benchmark we strive to achieve.
 - \$13,626 in donations from 73 partners
 - Narnia themed escape room scheduled for Sunday 10/13 and Monday 10/14.
 - All spots filled for participation in escape room
